Check-In: Tuesday, October 4, 2022, 10 am to 2 pm

Show: Saturday, October 8, 2022, at 10 am
Release: Saturday, October 8, 2022, at 8 pm

All entries must be made online this year.

Entry Information

- **All entries must be made online at clevelandcountyfair.com.** Follow the links on the fair's website to Cleveland County Fair's Blue Ribbon Online Entry page. Entries and payments must be received by Cleveland County Fair by 4 pm September 14, 2022.
- Entry fee is \$10 per head. There is a one-time \$2.00 fee to create an online account.
- Payment must be made online through the Blue Ribbon software. Follow instructions to enter your payment information upon checkout. Registration and payments must be received by 4:00 p.m. September 14, 2022. Note that registration is not considered complete until Cleveland County Fair has received payment for any fees. No entries will be accepted after 4:00 pm September 14, 2022.
- Written proof of age must be provided for horses and ponies less than one year of age and **must be uploaded to the online portal when making online entries.**
- Space is assigned in the order entries are received, and shows are limited to available stall space. Once available space is filled, no other entries will be accepted. Make your entries early.
- All exhibitors and entries must comply with Cleveland County Fair rules. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to read and be familiar with ALL rules.

Check-In

- All weaned horses and ponies must be accompanied by:
 - Written proof and approval negative test for equine infectious anemia.
 - Original Coggins report dated within 12 months of the opening day of the fair must be presented once the animal arrives at the fairgrounds.
 - **A copy of the Coggins report certified by the issuing veterinarian should be uploaded to the online portal when making online entries.**

HORSES, PONIES, DONKEY AND MULE SHOWS - C

- Written proof of age must be provided for horses and ponies less than one year of age. A copy of proof **must be uploaded to the online portal when making online entries.**
- Horses and ponies must not be offloaded until the Coggins report has been verified by the director or his approved representation.
- Those animals showing signs of illness will be barred from entry.
- All animals must be pre-registered for competition. Only animals registered in competitions will be allowed to be offloaded. You should receive a registration confirmation after you have finalized your entries online.
- Vehicles and trailers must be moved to Livestock Parking area outside of Gate 10 immediately after unloading.
- See the Director for gate admission and parking pass at check-in.
- Two exhibitor passes will be issued per entry.

Rules & Regulations

- Exhibitors must maintain control of their animals at all times in the show ring.
- Exhibitors removing their animals prior to the posted release time shall forfeit all premiums earned and shall be prohibited from competition at the Cleveland County Fair the following year.
- Show horses being exhibited at other fairs are not permitted to arrive late or leave early unless prior permission has been granted by the department director.
- The exhibitor will be expected to:
 - Provide onsite supervision of their animals.
 - Keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition.
 - Remove all litter or equipment promptly as the superintendent may direct.
- Other considerations:
 1. The management reserves the right of declining any entry.
 2. Furthermore, the directors reserve the right to bar from the competition:
 - Animals of decided poor conformation.
 - Animals fitted properly for the show.
 - Animals not possessing sufficient merit to warrant recognition.
 3. Exhibitors are expected to:
 - Display their animals as directed by the fair management.
 - Accept assigned pen spaces without controversy.
 - Keep their animals and display in attractive appearance.
 - Cooperate with the department in every way such as may serve to increase the educational value of the exhibits and shows.

4. Exhibitors failing to promptly exhibit their animals in the arena to be rated by the judge as per schedule shall forfeit the privilege of competition. Decorations with ribbons previously won by animals in the show shall be prohibited until after the awards have been made in their respective classes. Current Cleveland County Fair ribbons must be displayed.
 5. An experienced judge shall rule on each class.
 6. The judge shall determine proper placing in the absence of competition in any class. Should unsound, inferior, or distinctly unworthy specimens be presented in competition, the Fair shall be under no obligation to decorate them with ribbons or distribute prizes as scheduled. Merit alone shall justify recognition.
- Furthermore, exhibitors must agree to comply with the following show guidelines.

Show Guidelines

- To be eligible to show in competitive classes, the exhibitor must be nine years of age or older on the day of the show.
- The fair will make a non-competitive participation/training class available as an option for young exhibitors who may require assistance from an adult in the show ring. Exhibitors eight years of age and under may only show in the participation/training class. Horses and ponies used in the participation/training class may also show in correct competition class by a qualified family member.
- Each exhibitor is limited to two entries in the Miniature Division, Pony Division, English Horse Division, Donkey Division, Work Horse and Mule Division, and Western Horse Division.
- Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class.
- Any individual horse or pony may compete in only one division. For example, English or Western Division, not both.
- Horses and/or ponies must be fitted and shown by the exhibitor. In an emergency, a substitute show person may be used pending approval by the department director.
- Junior exhibitors 9-19 years of age must have fitted, cared for, and be in the possession of their animals for 30 or more days immediately prior to the opening day of the fair.
- The department director is responsible for determining classes for entrants. Entries will not be changed, nor substitutions allowed after entries are received, unless approved by the department director.
- Individual animals may only be shown once in fitting and showmanship. Exhibitors must have an entry in a competitive class to show in showmanship.
- Exhibitors must have animals ready and enter the show ring promptly when classes are called. Animals not in place within three minutes will be disqualified and barred from competition.
- Discourteous and unsportsmanlike behavior by exhibitors or ringside affiliates will not be tolerated. Violation could lead to disqualification and one year ban from competition in the horse and pony department at the Cleveland County Fair.

Stalls

- Only animals accepted for stall space will be allowed to show. No Exceptions.
- Thirty stalls are available for each show. These will be assigned by the department director in the order the entries are received (based on date/timestamp of online entry.)
- No stall may be bedded, decorated, locked, or otherwise claimed until official assignments have been posted by the director.
- Feed must be furnished by the exhibitor. The fair will not have feed available for sale.
- Cleveland County Fair will provide a layer of sawdust in the stalls. Care will be exercised to have all stalls clean and bedded with a suitable base material (sawdust) at the time of entry. Exhibitors must provide all additional bedding. The fair will not have bedding available for sale.
- Exhibitors are expected to keep their stalls clean.
- Exhibitors are expected to ensure that the horses and ponies are fed and watered regularly.
- Unclaimed or otherwise empty stalls may not be used for storing tack, feed or equipment until approved by the director. Such stalls will be made available by the director on a first-come first-served basis.

Health and Safety

- All weaned horses and ponies must be accompanied by:
 - Written proof and approval negative test for equine infectious anemia.
 - Original Coggins report dated within 12 months of the opening day of the fair must be presented.
A copy of the Coggins report should be uploaded to the online portal when making online entries. See Livestock and Horse Health Regulations at clevelandcountyfair.com.
- Horses and ponies must not be off-loaded until the Coggins report has been verified by the director or his approved representative.
- All animals, regardless of age, must be shown at halter. All animals must be haltered except when confined to a stall.
- No weaned stud horses or ponies will be accepted. All weaned males must be castrated and healed.
- Children 10 years of age and younger may be assisted by an adult if needed during showing of the animals. All other exhibitors must be capable of showing animals without assistance in the show ring.
- Any horse or pony deemed by the director to be a threat to the safety of exhibitors, spectators or other animals will be promptly returned to the farm of origin.
- Animals are permitted to be exercised only on the parking field and this must be completed by 2 p.m. each day. Horses and ponies must be saddled and unsaddled outside of the gate.
- **The Cleveland County Fair shall not be responsible for any accident which may occur to or by reason of any exhibit animals. The exhibitor shall hold the Cleveland County Fair blameless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings arising from such actions.**
