Entry Information

- No limit on number of entries per farm.
- All entries must be made online at clevelandcountyfair.com. Follow the links on the fair's website to Cleveland County Fair's Blue Ribbon Online Entry page. Entries and payments must be received by Cleveland County Fair by 4 pm September 14, 2022.
- Entry fee is \$10 per head. There is an additional one-time \$2.00 fee to create an online account.
- Payment must be made online through the Blue Ribbon software. Follow instructions to enter your payment information upon checkout. Registration and payments must be received by 4:00 pm. September 14, 2022. Note that registration is not considered complete until Cleveland County Fair has received payment for any fees.
- Space is assigned in the order entries are received, and the show is limited to available pen space.
- No entries will be accepted after 4:00 pm September 14, 2022.
- Exhibitors removing their animals from the barn prior to posted release time shall forfeit premiums.
- Substitutions are permitted, but you must call the Cleveland County Fair office (704-487-0651) with animal information prior to bringing the animal to the fair. Any animal not in the show book prior to arrival will not be allowed to be offloaded.
- All exhibitors and entries must comply with Cleveland County Fair rules. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to read and be familiar with ALL rules.

Check-In

- Present Certificate of Veterinary Inspection to health inspector prior to offloading. A health check of all animals will be performed on the grounds. Those animals showing signs of illness will be barred from entry.
- All animals must be pre-registered for competition. Only animals registered in competitions will be allowed to be offloaded.
- Vehicles and trailers must be moved to Livestock Parking area outside of Gate 10 immediately after unloading.
- See the Director for gate admission and parking pass at check-in.

Sanctioned Show Rules and Cleveland County Fair Rules & Regulations

- This show is sanctioned by the American Boer Goat Association, and ABGA rules shall govern. Visit abga.org for complete details.
- All entries must comply with both ABGA and Cleveland County Fair rules. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to read and be familiar with all rules.
- The base date for computing age of animals is October 4, 2022.
- All animals entering the grounds must be accompanied by a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (health papers) dated within 60 days of show and must comply with USDA Scrapie Eradication Program guidelines. See Livestock and Horse Health Regulations at clevelandcountyfair.com.
- Pens are made available to exhibitors on a first-come, first-served basis. Exhibitors are asked to use pens sparingly to provide space for others.
- Exhibitors must be capable of showing animals without assistance in the show ring.
- Cleveland County Fair will provide base bedding for animal pens. Exhibitors may bring wood shavings for top dressing. Bedding with straw is NOT permitted.
- Exhibitors removing their animals prior to the announced release time shall forfeit all premiums earned.
- No animal bracing allowed at ABGA Sanctioned Shows: Goats' front legs must be on the ground during judging. Front feet must remain on the arena floor during judge's evaluation. Exhibitors may lift feet off the ground for a period not to exceed 10 seconds when posing the goat.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to refrain from presenting any animal owned by the presiding judge within 90 days prior to the show date.
